

♪ Apparel & Spirit Wear ♪

What apparel is required?

Performance uniforms for Marching Band, Color Guard, Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Symphonic Winds, and Wind Ensemble are issued by the school. All Marching Band participants will purchase a “Marching Bundle” including the meal plan, show shirt, and gloves, and all Color Guard participants will likewise purchase a “Guard Bundle” which includes the meal plan and show shirt. Marching shoes, or “Dinkles”, will be fitted at the school. Color Guard jackets, bags, and shoes will similarly be issued by the school. Bundles, shoes, and Color Guard jackets and bags, are the property of the student and are invoiced via CHARMS.

Performance uniforms may come home periodically for cleaning. Cleaning instructions can be found on the Legacy Bands website, under Docs & Forms, at <http://legacybands.org/docs-forms/>. Abbreviated instructions will also be emailed, as well as posted on the Legacy Bands Community Facebook page.

Additionally, students must have Legacy Band polo shirts, as well as khaki trousers and khaki shorts for football games, pep assemblies, and out-of-state travel days. Khakis and Legacy Band polo shirts are not provided by the school. *Polo shirts must be purchased separately through the CHARMS online store.* Khakis and shorts can be purchased through any vendor of the student’s choice. (Old Navy often has a great selection of not-too-expensive options in lots of sizes, and - bonus! - RaiseRight usually has great return rates for Old Navy purchases.)

~~Please note: During non-travel years, Color Guard members are not required to purchase the Legacy Band polo; however, as 2022-2023 is a travel year, Color Guard members are required to purchase the polo, and wear the polo and khakis for airplane travel. (REMOVED 05/14/2022)~~

What other items are available for purchase through the CHARMS online store?

In addition to the Legacy Band student polo, “Legacy Band Parent” and “Legacy Band Grandparent” polos are available, and are often worn while volunteering and at events, as is Pit Crew apparel. Show shirts can also be purchased by non-students. Family apparel is an excellent way to support our students, and represent our community in the stands.

Spirit Wear, such as t-shirts, hooded sweatshirts, zip-up thermal sweatshirts, bucket hats, baseball caps, beanies, and more, is optional gear, and is also available through CHARMS. It is common for students and family members to wear Spirit Wear at games, competitions, parades, practice, while traveling, and while volunteering.

Legacy Band and Legacy Color Guard car decals can also be ordered through CHARMS. Show your pride for your student by purchasing these fun and sturdy decals for every car in the household. How fun it is to pull into the parking lot and see all of our band families’ cars!

When is the CHARMS online store open for orders?

Because we manage our inventory through bulk orders with our vendor, we must limit our orders to specific windows within the year. We have two order windows:

- 1) Last two weeks of the school year; delivery approx. end of June/beginning of July
- 2) First two weeks of mandatory band camp (starts August 1); delivery approx. end of August

Family show shirts are only available during the mandatory band camp window.

How can I pay for apparel and Spirit Wear orders?

Payments for online store items can be submitted within Charms by credit card by selecting the Paypal option in the checkout page (a small fee applies), or you can select "Bill and Print" to pay by check or cash. If paying by check or cash, please affix a note with the payment, identifying your name, your student's name, and what your payment is for, and have your student drop the payment in the "BAND BOX" in the Band Room. Please make checks payable to **Legacy Band Boosters.**
