How do the Legacy Band Boosters financially support the Legacy Band Program?

The Legacy Band Boosters provide many more services than the district can fund. In order to cover the cost of these services, the Boosters raise money to cover these expenses. The four main ways Boosters fund the Legacy Band Program are:

- Legacy Marching Festival: We are honored to have the opportunity to host excellent bands from around the state at our own Marching Festival, and we can't succeed without our fantastic Parent Volunteers who pitch in for this one special day each fall.
- Mattress Fundraiser: You've probably seen our students dancing on the corner of Zuni and 136th Avenue in mattress costumes each April to entice customers to this unique fundraiser. Friends and family get excellent deals on high quality mattresses and bedding, and we get great commissions to add to our fundraising income.
- King Soopers Community Rewards Program: You and your family can immediately start earning money for our Band program by simply linking your Loyalty number or Alternative ID to Community Rewards=Legacy HS Band Boosters.
- Student Fundraising Goal (FRG): We ask every student to financially contribute annually to the Legacy Band Program. This can be done either by paying the band directly, or by participating in one or all of our many fundraising opportunities, such as our summer Palisade peach sale, our fall Holiday Wreath Sale and Butter Braids sale, our spring See's Candies sales, and our ShopWithScrip/RaiseRight gift card program.

How is this income used?

This income covers uniforms; transportation to competitions and football games; additional marching and instrument instructors; marching equipment; color guard equipment; percussion equipment; music licensing; show design; and much more.

When is the Student Fundraising Goal (FRG) due?

On non-trip years, the Fundraising Goal is due by May 31. During trip years, the FRG is due prior to trip departure. For the 2022-2023 school year, the FRG is due 10/31/2022.

Are there additional costs associated with the Legacy Band Program?

Costs vary depending on the student's section. Families are responsible for: Marching footwear, Band polo, show shirt, instrument supplies (drum sticks, reeds), track suit (Color Guard), and the meal plan.

How are finances tracked?

The Legacy Band Program uses an online financial tracker called CHARMS. This website - www.charmsoffice.com - will be your source for tracking your fundraising, ordering online store items, paying for trips, and much more.

Can our family receive financial aid to offset expenses?

The Legacy Band Boosters is committed to making this program accessible to ALL students, regardless of financial situation. Financial need is addressed on a case-by-case basis. Please contact Dr. Ebert or the Finance Team (finance@legacybands.org) with questions or concerns.



Please log into your account and make sure all the information in there is correct. If there is an error, please let us know at finance@legacybands.org


Click the "LOGIN" button

We accept payment by credit card, check, or cash. Payments for online store items can be submitted within Charms by credit card by selecting the Paypal option in the checkout page (a small fee applies), or you can select "Bill and Print" to pay by check or cash. Trip or FRG payments can be submitted online by credit card (small fee applies) by selecting the trip and clicking "Make Fundraising Payment", or by cash or check. If paying by check or cash, please affix a note with the payment, identifying your name, your student's name, and what your payment is for, and have your student drop the payment in the "BAND BOX" in the Band Room.
